Your adventure begins as soon as you arrive at Entebbe International Airport. Here you will be picked up by a driver who will then transport you to the GuineaFowl- a mid-range Guesthouse (15mins drive from the airport). Here you can relax or, depending on your arrival time, spend some time exploring before settling in for a good night's sleep.





## Day 2&3

### Kidepo Valley National Park

#### Day 2: Transfer to Kidepo Valley National Park

Today is a travel day, you will drive from Entebbe to Kidepo Valley National Park in 9 to 10 hours. The journey is long but the scenery is beautiful. On your way to the park there will be enough time to stop and stretch your legs, lunch will be taken en-route in Gulu or Kitgum. You will check in at the lodge in the late afternoon.

#### Day 3: Safari walk and game drive.

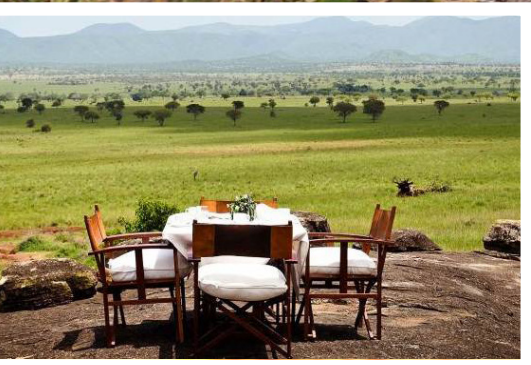
The day starts with an early breakfast, after breakfast you will explore the park during an on-foot guided safari walk. You will be accompanied by an armed ranger. The ranger will explain to you about the unique flora and fauna in Kidepo Valley National Park. The safari walk will take 2 to 3 hours. After the walk you will first enjoy a (packed) lunch. The afternoon is spent enjoying a game drive in the park.

## Day 4&5



### Murchison Falls National Park

#### Day 3: Transfer to Murchison Falls National Park.

After breakfast, if time allows maybe a last short game drive! It is time to leave Kidepo behind. You will drive to Murchison Falls National Park where you check in at Murchison River Lodge. The drive takes about 5 to 6 hours with a few stops on your way.

#### Day 4: Early morning game drive and boat cruise.

6am, the alarm goes off and at 7 you're on your way to spot game in the park. After the ride, it is back to the lodge for lunch. At 2pm the boat trip on the Nile starts, to the bottom of the Murchison Falls. This takes about 3 hrs and you'll see plenty animals, such as Hippos, Buffalo, Crocodiles and some Elephants. For those in good physical condition, there is the possibility to be deposited at the bottom of the Waterfall and hike up, along it. This hike is pretty steep and slippery. Afterward, it is time for dinner at the lodge.

## Day 6&7

### **Kibale Forest National park(Chimps)**

#### **Day 6: Travel day to Kibale Forest National park**

Today the journey continues to Kibale NP, a 6-7 hour drive. The journey is long but with beautiful varied landscapes, the hills and mountains you drive through become greener and greener, until you reach the tea plantations of Fort Portal!

#### **Day 7: Chimpanzee tracking and Bigodi swamp walk.**

Time to look for Chimpanzees in Kibale NP. First, get briefed by the rangers. The walk starts in the rainforest, - it can be quite heavy, so wear appropriate shoes and a poncho. Listen carefully to hear the Chimps, the rangers are trained so chances are that you will find them! After the Chimp trek it is time for lunch and then a walk through the marsh, where you will spot different birds and some monkeys. If you still feel like a walk then you can go to "top of the world" where you have beautiful views of the area with a number of crater lakes.

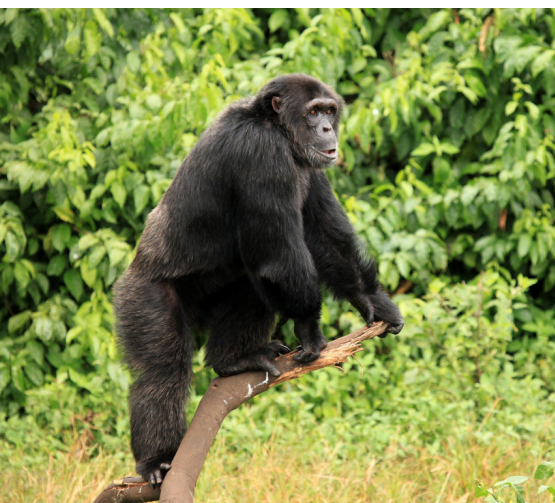

#### **Day 9: Game drive to Kasenyi and Ishasha tree climbing lions**

Today you get up early for the game drive to Kasenyi – the area with the biggest chance to spot lions, and many other predators i.e Hyenas and Leopards. After the game drive, continue to the most southern part of Queen Elizabeth, Ishasha, known for tree-climbing lions.

##### **Bullbush River Camp**

Mid-range lodge located inside Ishasha Sector

## Day 10&11

### **Bwindi Impenetrable National Park (Gorillas)**

#### **Day 10: Ishasha game drive and transfer to Bwindi National Park**

The day starts with a game drive in Ishasha, after which you will drive to Bwindi National Park – Buhoma sector – and check in at the lodge. The afternoon is at leisure so you can prepare for the Gorilla trekking in the morning. You can opt for a village or nature walk or visit a Batwa Community.

#### **Day 11: Gorilla tracking in Bwindi Impenetrable Forest National Park**

Today is the day to track the mountain gorillas in Bwindi NP. After breakfast you go to the rangers post for the briefing. After the briefing, the search for the Mountain Gorillas begins. Depending on the location of the family you are going to visit, the trip can take a few hours. The landscape is mountainous so wear good walking shoes. After this exciting experience, it's time to relax at the lodge and view your photos.

##### **Buhoma Gorilla Camp**

Mid-range lodge located just outside Bwindi NP

#### **Meals and Drinks**

- All meals included
- Drinking water (Other drinks not included)





## Day 12&13

### Lake Mburo National Park

#### Day 12: Transfer to Lake Mburo National Park

After breakfast you will drive towards Lake Mburo National Park and check in at the lodge. The afternoon is spent during a game drive and an optional boat cruise on the lake. Lake Mburo National Park is known for its large herd of Zebra and since recent a small population of Rothschild's Giraffe.

#### Day 13: Safari walk and afternoon game drive

The day starts with a guided walking safari or a Mountain bike ride. During the safari walk you will be accompanied by an armed ranger. After lunch you will enjoy another game drive in the park, and a sundowner on one of the hills surrounding the lake.

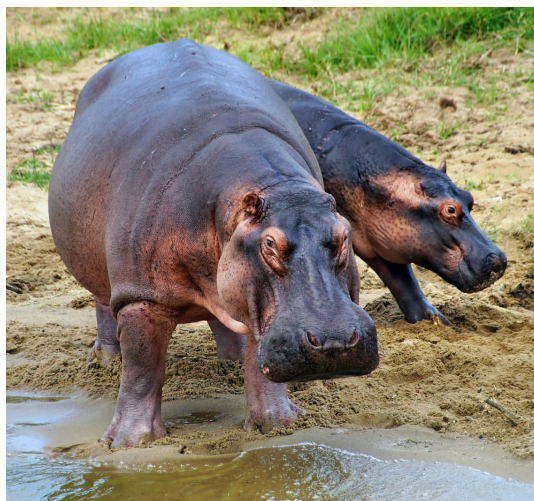
